Footnotes

CURRENCY SWAP lugged out while outside the center of the track on the backstretch, was guided in near the half-mile pole, ranged up while four wide on the turn, continued to have the rider tug on the left rein, was asked for a bit more while making a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, sat off the leaders hip into the stretch, was roused to the lead in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, disposed of TAKES THE GOLD entering the final furlong and drew away under a vigorous hand ride. AFRICANIST was taken in hand when pressure came from the outside in the early going, settled in the middle of the field while under urging, raced near the rail on the turn, was put to a right-handed whip in upper stretch and got up for the place at the wire. TAKES THE GOLD came away in good order, quickly crossed in front of the field, contested the pace on the inside of STREET FIGHT, inched clear of that rival while off the rail midway through the turn, was challenged by the winner near the five-sixteenths pole, lost the lead to that rival while under left hand urging in upper stretch and proved no match then was caught for the place at the wire. GRANDPA LEN bumped with a rival at the start, was well placed just off the pace while under some urging, chased inside on the turn, moved out while under a right-handed whip in upper stretch and weakened. MINESTONE bumped with GRANPA LEN at the start, was ridden along while off the pace, raced two then three wide on the turn, swung five wide at the top of the stretch and failed to threaten. TRADE raced just off the pace while off the inside, shifted four wide midway through the turn, was roused shortly thereafter, chased four wide into the stretch and came up empty. A SINGLE MAN was last away, raced well back in the field, went four wide on the turn and was no factor. RED JACK dropped back while ridden along, drifted wide on the turn, was six wide into the stretch and faltered. STREET FIGHT moved up after the start, disputed the pace on the outside, dropped back outside the five-sixteenths pole and stopped.
