HANGOVER KID bumped with a rival at the start, was rated in the front half of the field, went two to three wide on the second turn, settled on the backstretch, chased two to three wide on the far turn, took the lead in upper stretch, inched clear under a right-handed whip, drifted out under continued right hand urging in the final furlong and held gamely. SOLITAIRE dropped to the rear entering the first turn, was unhurried towards the back, moved out late on the backstretch, advanced four to five wide on the final turn, rallied on the outside, drifted in while gaining on HANGOVER KID, loomed boldly on the outside, was carried out by the aforementioned rival and was denied. ANIMAL SPIRITS hit the outside stall door lightly at the break, went three then two wide on the first turn, was rated just off the pace, raced inside on the second turn, continued just off the pace, was ridden along while inside on the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch, pursued the winner into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. SITUATIONAL ETHICS came off the inside late on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, raced three to four wide while urged along on the third turn, angled out in upper stretch and failed to rally. WESTSIDE CORRAL was caught four wide early on the first turn, dropped to one off the rail late on that turn, lingered at the back, saved ground on the second turn, continued at the back, was urged along while inside early on the far turn then came off the rail and failed to threaten. SOUL OF BORREGO went two then three wide on the first turn, was reserved towards the back, saved ground on the second turn, continued off the pace, was urged along while three then two wide on the final turn, chose the inside route at the top of the stretch and also failed to rally. ENGLISH MAJOR went to the early lead, set the pace, relinquished the advantage the first time down the stretch, saved ground on the second turn, was the first of the field to be roused in the vicinity of the half-mile pole and failed to respond. COLOSSAL GIFT bumped with a rival at the start then was in tight, went three wide while eager on the first turn, dragged his way closer down the stretch the first time, took the lead passing the wire, moved to a clear advantage, was asked outside the quarter-pole, lost the lead near the three-sixteenths pole and gave way.
