

**Footnotes**

BANSHEE BREEZE broke alertly, was carried out into the first turn, angled to the inside midway on the first turn, advanced on the rail on the backstretch, came through an opening along the inside turning for home and prevailed under a drive. BEAUTIFUL PLEASURE set the pace while removed from the inner railing, responded when joined from the inside by the winner and stayed on gamely to the finish. HERITAGE OF GOLD, inside on the first turn, angled out and chased the pace while three wide then tired in the stretch. MOSSFLOWER, taken in hand after the start, raced outside and had no response when asked. DIGGINS, wide on the first turn, dropped back along the rail and tired badly.
