SHELTERFROMASTORM was rated along early, advanced on the second turn, split rivals nearing the stretch, came wide for the drive, finished strongly outside and was along late while not fully extended at the finish, winning with something left. OMI PRINCESS showed good speed along the inside, was rated along early, rallied inside into the stretch and dug in gamely on the hedge. WESTERN FLAIR raced in hand early, put in a wide run on the second turn and faded in the final furlong. GABRIELA'S ROSE was rated along early, came wide into the stretch and had no impact on the outcome. DRESSED TO KILL hesitated at the start, was outrun early, rallied four wide on the second turn and finished gamely outside. HOLIDAY TUNE raced wide early, was steadied on the backstretch, put in a four wide run on the second turn and tired in the final furlong. COLONIAL PROMISE raced close up early, raced greenly along the inside and tired in the stretch. BEE HIVE was outrun early, put in a three wide run on the second turn and tired in the stretch. ESPANOLA WAY was used to make the lead from her outside post, set the pace for three quarters and tired. CHIANTI RED tired after a half mile.
