Footnotes

RED HOT BULLET steadied in traffic along the inside on the first turn, moved out on the backstretch, swung four wide while gaining on the turn, made a run to threaten in midstretch end edged clear. A. P. LIGHT was outrun to the turn, circled six wide into the stretch and finished strongly to gain the place. MUSICAL SPLENDOR set the pace along the rail into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. TIMELY COMMAND stalked the pace between horses, lodged a bid in upper stretch and weakened late. LORRAINE IN SPAIN steadied in traffic early, saved ground while well back, rallied along the rail in upper stretch then angled out while gaining in the late stages. WISE CHOICE saved ground early, angled between horses and finished evenly. SMALL POTATOES steadied in traffic early, rushed up three wide, pressed the pace to the turn and tired. ALEXANDRITE RING was outrun to the turn then raced in traffic between horses in the stretch. DELECTABLE CAT was outrun. MAMBO CHACHACHA steadied along the inside for a half mile and gave way.
