TRICKLE TRICKLE battled heads apart from outside into upper stretch and edged clear under intermittent urging. PUNTA NIZUC dueled inside the winner and was all out to narrowly hold the place. IDOL IMAGE raced up close along the rail, angled 3wide and closed late to narrowly miss the place. PLEASANT PRINCE raced in the middle of the pack, angled to the inside in upper stretch and lacked a late response. TIGER WILLIE failed to threaten after breaking slowly. DICKIE B raced just off the pace three wide for a half and tired. TIGER BOY was never a factor.
