Footnotes

I'M YOUR LADY raced between horses for a half, checked in traffic and swung four wide on the turn, charged to the front in midstretch and edged away under pressure. LOXY LADY was well placed for five furlongs, waited for room while saving ground midway on the turn, angled out to get clear in midstretch then finished willingly to gain the place. DEPUTY EMPRESS was outrun after breaking slowly, made a quick five wide move to threaten nearing the quarter pole but couldn't sustain his bid. WHO IS LADY came in slightly on the first turn, angled out, pressed the pace on the backstretch, lodged a bid to challenge on the turn, battled heads apart into midstretch and weakened late. DEAR CONTENDER steadied in traffic on the far turn, raced between horses to the turn then rallied mildly. KALEIDOSCOPE SKY steadied and was carried wide on the first turn, was under a firm hold for a half, raced in midpack on the turn and finished evenly. MARIA'S MOON set the pace along the rail for six furlongs and gave way. MYNIA steadied and was carried out in traffic on the first turn and failed to threaten thereafter. KITTY'S WISH steadied in traffic on the first turn, raced up close for five furlongs and faded on the turn. JOHN'S JEAN steadied and hit the rail, causing the rider to come out of the irons on the first turn, raced up close for a half and gave way.
