CRAVIN CADEN was carried out a bit at the start, dropped back then moved in at the rear of the field, was urged along while three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, closed well under left hand urging, took the lead near the sixteenth-pole then edged clear under good handling. BANK HEIST was a bit fractious in the gate, showed good speed, angled to the inside leaving the chute, set the pace, dictated terms while inside on the turn, came off the rail at the top of the stretch, remained clear into the final furlong but was overtaken while clear for the place. CAFE DES ARTISTES broke outward at the start, was urged along near the back of the field, raced two then three wide on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the show. BELLHOUSE tracked the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn, was roused near the five-sixteenths pole, chased the winner into the final furlong and weakened. AE PIT was bumped soundly at the start and broke last, raced well back in the field, went four wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and improved position in the middle of the track. DOCTOR PEACH chased the leader while on the inside of BELLHOUSE, continued the chase while off the rail on the turn and tired. DO IT ALL broke outward and bumped with a rival, raced well back in the field while near the inside, saved ground on the turn, eased off the rail in mid-stretch and failed to rally. JAGUAR PAW bobbled slightly at the start, settled in the middle of the field, was urged along while near the rail on the turn and failed to respond. HOLIDAY BALLAD settled on the inside, was urged along while saving ground on the turn and came up empty. JUST HOLD ON was reluctant to load, raced towards the front early, was taken up nearing the five-eighths pole, went three wide while urged along on the turn and also came up empty. ENCLOSURE settled in the back half of the field, was roused while two to three wide on the turn and failed to threaten.
