Footnotes

HURLING strung out in the three path around the opening bend, remained parked well off the inside throughout, travelled along the border of the overland route while advancing into contention during the run around the subsequent one, turned for home and was roused, gained readily on the leader during the ensuing furlong, wore down that one soon afterwards and edged away, driving. ALLEN'S STAR broke awkwardly, sat reserved from the outside in the middle of the pack for nearly three-quarters, began to pick up the pace as the field headed for the quarter pole, rallied willingly down the lane to secure second. KNOCKOUT tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, moved up to issue a challenge for the lead coming to midpoint on the far turn,

took over soon afterwards, offered some resistance before relinquishing just past the eighth pole, weakened thereafter into the show slot. NEWMAN ROCKS off the inside, rallied belatedly. POSITIVE CARRY scooted past rivals to assume a forward position, prompted the pacesetter from the three path, remained a prominent factor until midstretch before backing away. IMASPEEDYGUY was no factor. PERFECTION PLUS rated in the two path, was put to the test coming to the three-eighths pole, succumbed to the pressure and steadily tired thereafter. GREELEY'S LAW was taken in hand while in a bit tight between rivals early on the first turn, sat within range from the outside, was through after completing three-quarters. TELL GRANT steadied along the first turn, was almost midway down the backstretch before acted more professionally, was taken over to the inside in time for the run around the far turn, had little left after entering the stretch. PURE KRAFT bore out both turns and was eased before reaching the top of the stretch. PROUD GEORGE wilted off a ground-saving journey and was eased.
