VICTORY ISLAND chased the pace on the outside then four wide early on the turn, dropped to three wide around the five-sixteenths pole, came under a right-handed whip at the top of the stretch, made a bid while switched to a left-handed whip passing the three-sixteenths pole, shook clear of FLEA FLICKER inside the furlong marker and drew away under continued left hand urging then a strong hand ride late. FLEA FLICKER chased the pace, raced three early on the turn, made a bid while one off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole, gained a short lead at the top of the stretch, disposed of WINNING CASE but was immediately challenged by VICTORY ISLAND, lost the lead shortly thereafter, battled into the final furlong while under left hand urging and proved no match while well clear for the place. NOTESFROMABROAD was away alertly, brushed with a rival after the start, was sent hard to duel for the lead, dropped back near the seven-sixteenths pole, chased on the turn, came off the inside near the five-sixteenths pole, moved out under right hand urging in upper stretch and weakened while clear for the show. CAPE COD CAROL was fractious in the gate then last away, raced well back in the field, saved ground on the turn, swung out outside the three-sixteenths pole and failed to threaten. SHOT GUN PENNIE came out at the start then was corrected by the rider, chased the pace, dropped back while climbing badly from the half-mile pole to the seven-sixteenths pole, raced three then two wide on the turn, inched closer to the rail near the five-sixteenths pole, came under the whip at the top of the stretch and tired. WINNING CASE dueled on the outside, inched clear passing the seven-sixteenths pole, dropped to the inside midway through the turn, was challenged near the five-sixteenths pole, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and gave way. MILLIONS IN MOTION lugged out at the break then was corrected with the left rein by the rider, dropped back while ridden along, raced inside early on the turn, moved out four wide by the five-sixteenths pole, floated five wide at the top of the stretch, drifted in near the three-sixteenths pole and showed little. DARN THAT TRIP was carried out at the start, raced on the outside while ridden along, went three to four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to respond.
