Footnotes

D' ORATORY advanced in the right direction and took up the role of stalker, sat patiently parked in the two path, under a firm hold, and just off the leader's hind quarters until the half mile pole, was let out a notch and drew abreast of MARIE'S BABE early on the far turn, bided time racing heads apart with the aforementioned rival for a short distance more, was let out a notch and took over in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home and was set down to a drive, gradually increased the lead making her way through the furlong grounds, but with danger lurking both to the inside and to the outside, dug in with good determination and under strong handling to fend off both GO UNBRIDLED and BEAUTIFUL RISK to preserve the decision. GO UNBRIDLED was put under a snug hold nearing the end of the homestretch, proceeded around the opening bend in tight quarters, requiring the rider to eventually take hold and steady the mount, lost momentum as a result and fell back slightly more than a length, got back going in short order and made up the lost ground in no time, rated kindly between rivals during the run around the far turn before being asked for some run nearing the quarter pole, cleared the now fading former pacesetter and altered course to the rail in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, closed in on the leader to loom a serious threat with an eighth to go, continued to cut into that one's margin but came up short at the end. BEAUTIFUL RISK raced three wide on the far turn, was put to a drive commencing from midpoint and closed willingly en route for the show. LIFE'S MEASURE sat wedged between rivals for a good portion of the way on the first turn, tucked over to the inside soon after entering the backstretch, remained along the rail before slipping outward just past the five-sixteenths pole, gearing up for the stretch run, angled three wide into the lane, failed to fire after being called upon. LANDLASH saved ground around the second turn, angled five wide into upper stretch, had no rally. THERE GOES MOLLY three wide on the first turn, remained well off the inside thereafter, was through after completing

three-quarters. MARIE'S BABE rated along the inside while showing the way, was confronted by the eventual winner at the seven-sixteenths pole, kept pace with that opponent for the next quarter, yielded and faded. KAYDEROSS underwent a three to four wide journey, drifted very while tiring into the stretch, then was eased. ALYKELA had little left to offer after entering the stretch and was eased to the wire.
