Footnotes

BUFFUM was well placed behind the top two while in hand, continued behind the leaders while off the rail on the turn, split those rivals to make a bid passing the five-sixteenths pole while still in hand, was asked a bit coming to the quarter-pole, drove clear under strong hand urging in upper stretch, continued to widen in the final furlong with the rider poised like a statue and won as the rider pleased. NACHO SAINT pressed the pace on the outside, was urged along while two then three wide on the turn, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch and proved no match for the winner while clear for the place. WASHINGTON'S RULES bumped with COLJAK at the start then was crowded a bit, raced at the rear of the field while urged along, came under stronger urging while just off the rail on the turn, shifted four wide outside the quarter-pole, drifted out under left hand urging nearing the furlong marker, was switched to a right-handed whip and got up for the show. WANSTEAD settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the turn, came under right hand urging in upper stretch and tired. COLJAK bumped with WASHINGTON'S RULES at the start then was crowded a bit, settled towards the inside, came under some urging with a half-mile to run, saved ground while urged along on the turn, moved off the rail in upper stretch, came under a right-handed whip and had nothing left. BULAGA moved through on the inside of NACHO SAINT to take the lead, set the pace under some pressure, lost the advantage outside the quarter-pole and faded. CITY TROOPER was urged along while just off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and stopped.
