BELLY OF THE WHALE raced along the outside, picked up interest and swung three wide into the stretch, gained ground readily during the initial portion of the stretch run, maintained the momentum, rolling by a fighting twosome in deep stretch to prove best. MORE THAN CLASSIC hand urged after leaving the gate, went to to secure the front, was kept under some encouragement showing the way on the turn, entrenched in the two path, had ALL CASH advance and draw abreast leaving the midway point, sparred on even terms with the same opponent from that station onward, proved no match for the winner, but showed enough game ness to earn place honors. ALL CASH forwardly placed, saw clear passage down along the fence and was guided over to it a couple of jumps by the half mile pole, got roused before reaching the five-sixteenths pole and challenged the runner up in earnest, battled with distinction against that opponent the rest of the way to the finish line, having to settle for the show award. OTOY tracked the front runners from the inside, under some encouragement while undergoing the task, was taken outward after spinning into the lane and called upon for much more, failed to muster up the needed response. MACK MILLER was guided over to the rail before reaching the end of the backstretch, remained along the inside route around the bend, was asked for run angling out for the commencement of the stretch, had no rally. CATFIVE off the inside, was fanned into the four path while racing through the furlong grounds, had no offering. WAR HAWK three wide departing the backstretch, was four to five entering the stretch, failed to menace. LITTLE BOSS took up the chase from the three path, failed to attach himself to the leader, got set down coming to the five-sixteenths marker, started backing away shortly afterwards.
