PROFESSOR CHAOS three wide towards the rear, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths with a wall of rivals strewn out across the track in front, angled to be five wide into upper stretch, rallied with good energy into contention a furlong out, briefly tussled outside a pair, took command a sixteenth from home and inched away late. WON'TUALWAYSWonder ranged up early on to settle two to three wide in close aim of the front, shifted in a path three furlongs out, took command at the five-sixteenths under coaxing, swung three wide for home set down for the drive, fought on digging in stubborn to the eighth pole, staved off a pair when joined outside by the aforementioned rival, got headed a sixteenth out, battled on determined to hold for the place. SOLO APPROACH off the inside in mid pack, came under urging four to five wide three furlongs from home, continued five wide into the lane, rallied willingly battling head to head through the lane but ultimately could only secure the show honors while safely clear of the rest. MORAVITZ bumped and jostled a few steps from the gate when SHORTCOMING broke outwards, tracked the pace inside from mid pack, came under urging cutting the corner into the stretch, kicked on mildly to the eighth pole before weakening in the final furlong. CODE Z forwardly placed early on inside, gradually lost position through

the backside and into the far turn, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled four wide for home and made no late headway. BRANDY'S BIG GUY just off the pace three to four wide, got set down between foes at the five-sixteenths, continued four wide into upper stretch and weakened in the drive. SUNNYINSEABROOK steadied when squeezed back at the start between foes due to pressure from PRINCE CURLIN who veered in sharply, was then carried out at the six and a half as that same foe got out into the first turn along his inside, settled just off the inside towards the rear, came under urging three furlongs from home and offered no response. SHORTCOMING broke out at the start bumping MORAVITZ and jostling that foe for a few strides away from the gate, attended the pace from just off the inside, came under coaxing midway on the far turn, began to fade through to the quarter pole and tired. MISE EN PLACE on the pace in hand inside through comfortable fractions, came under coaxing when the pressure intensified in earnest midway on the far turn, was headed at the five-sixteenths and folded. PRINCE CURLIN veered in at the start bumping and squeezing SUNNYINSEABROOK back between foes, got out through into the first turn carrying that same rival out three paths or so at the six and a half, became detached from the main body of the field down the backside and made no further impact.
