BOND VIGILANTE came away in good order, showed good speed from the rail, was eased back to avoid an inside duel with MARRIEDTOTHMUSIC before the five-eighths pole, shifted quickly to the outside shortly thereafter, stalked the pacesetter on the outside then three wide on the turn, was given his cue near the five-sixteenths pole, chased into upper stretch, pursued the leader into the final furlong under strong hand urging, was given one crack of a right-handed whip inside the eighth-pole, gained the advantage coming to the sixteenth-pole then drew clear under a steady hand-ride. MARRIEDTOTHMUSIC bumped with a rival at the start but broke alertly, beat the winner to the early lead, set the pace while off the rail, was asked outside the quarter-pole, came under a left-handed whip outside the furlong marker, lost the lead approaching the sixteenth-pole and tired while able to hold the place. CHAPMAN broke out and smashed the outside of the gate, brushed with a rival then was taken immediately in hand, was headstrong while under a tight hold, fought the rider into the turn, leveled out while inside on the bend, cut the corner into the stretch, chased the leader under the whip and weakened while able to get the show. LONGFOR THE CITY was bumped at the start then brushed with another rival and was last away, settled on the outside, raced off the rail early on the turn, angled four wide near the quarter-pole, was asked at that point, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip in the vicinity of the furlong marker and failed to rally.
