Footnotes

WISDOM OF OZ darted over and into the two path after the start, making it there before reaching the end of the chute, latched on to the early leader coming to the half mile pole, raced as a team with that rival, without the closest pursuers making their presence felt, had the tussle spill over into the stretch, was put to a drive and chiseled down the advantage almost next to nothing by the eighth pole, forged to the front a few jumps later and edged away, driving. SCIENZIATO sat parked out in the three path off the pace dispute, was asked for run after going halfway around the bend, mustered up enough of a response to be along for the place. AMPA'S GIRL left the post parade early, bobbed outward taking her initial step out of the starting gate and made contact with HOOKED AGAIN, raced from off the inside, was under encouragement by the half mile pole, turned for home five wide, and rallied for the show. GINGEE rode the rail until the five-sixteenths marker, swung outward entering the stretch from the four path, displayed a mild response en route for the last major check. MONONOKE argued for command, under a firm hold during the opening stages, yielded shortly after departing the furlong marker and faltered. RUFUS RUTH saved ground for nearly a half, was under a drive prior to reaching the quarter pole, angled sharply into the four path travelling through the furlong grounds, flattened out. SARAH'S WILD GIRL bumped at the start, raced from off the inside throughout, had already felt the whip by midway on the turn, commenced the stretch from the six path, tired. HOOKED AGAIN bumped from both sides at the break, drifted seven wide turning for home, was only asked for some run during the initial portion of the stretch drive.
