STAKES New York Stallion Series S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

INNER TURF FOR THREE YEARS OLD WHICH ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THE NEW YORK STALLION STAKES. By subscription of \$200 due on or before December 1, 2010 or \$1,000 due on or before December 1, 2011 or \$5,000 due on or before September 1, 2012. A supplemental nomination fee of \$5,000 can be made at any time prior to the close of entries only if the stallion was fully subscribed and registered to the stallion stakes in the year of the progenies birth and such payment will qualify the horse for all future stallion stake races. \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 5% of purses won to be awarded to the stallion nominator. 123 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstake at a mile or over on the turf in 2013 or three races allowed 2 lbs.; a sweepstake or two races on the turf, 4 lbs.; a race at a mile or over on the turf, 6 lbs (Maiden and claiming races not considered). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

**Footnotes**

ORINO away in good order, quickly established control, was tucked along the rail approaching the end of the homestretch, cut the pace, being rated along, felt the pressure intensifying prior to the third fraction being recorded, got let out in response, was more in the two path than down along the rail by the commencement of the stretch, had WEST HILLS GIANT draw abreast by the end of the furlong grounds, looking him in the eye, started edging away from that opponent to be almost a length in front, had the rider switch over to some right handed stick work, drifted in slightly but enough to place the previously-mentioned opponent in tight quarters, bumping with and causing that one to make some contact with the rail, continued onward with fortitude to be the first to cross the wire. WEST HILLS GIANT was placed into the pocket only a few strides after the start, contently kept watch on the leader from there, got asked for a response spinning into the lane, launched a rail rally to latch on to the leader and pose a serious threat with a furlong remaining, failed to advance any further, appearing to have been successfully shaken off, had ORINO drift in slightly leaving the sixteenth maker resulting in getting placed in tight quarters, bumped with that foe and then bumped into the rail, showed good determination thereafter clinging to place honors. CAPTAIN GAUGHEN patiently prompted the pacesetter from the outside, under some light hand urging to maintain interest, was in the three path challenging in earnest as the field turned into the stretch, continued on in a willing manner down the lane, narrowing failing to catch the troubled official winner for second. OLD PAL OF MINE was sluggish in the early going, got taken outward entering the opening bend and remained at a considerate distance from the inside the rest of the way, picked up the pace tipping outward departing the backstretch until in the four path by the five-sixteenths pole, was slightly wider by the head of the stretch, mustered up a mild response once straightened away. MADAM I'M ADAM sat reserved in midpack along the outside, was cued up and proceeded to angle outward leaving the five-sixteenths pole until put four wide a furlong later, by this point under a drive, lacked the needed response. DEFERRED ASSET saved ground to no avail. SUN STORM three wide around both turns, folded. Following a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the stretch run, ORINO was disqualified from first and placed second for causing interference.
