Footnotes

PAN DULCE bumped lightly with rivals at the start, settled while under some urging, went three wide early on the turn, was driven five wide outside the quarter-pole, rallied to the lead in upper stretch, kicked clear under a right-handed whip into the final furlong and drew away under strong urging. SO ROYAL was hustled to the lead, set the pace through quick fractions, vied near the inside on the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, lost the lead in upper stretch and proved no match while clear for the place. BAAL PERAZIM was urged along while off the pace, brushed with a rival near the seven-sixteenths pole, went two then three wide early on the turn, moved to four wide outside the five-sixteenths pole, shifted five wide before the quarter-pole, was asked for her best in upper stretch and narrowly earned the show while no match for the top two. MALIBU MUDSLIDE bobbed at the start then bumped lightly with a rival and bobbed again, was urged along towards the rear, moved out near the seven-sixteenths pole, went four wide early on the turn, shifted six wide outside the quarter-pole and narrowly missed the show. BLUE BALLERINA was coaxed along while off the pace, brushed with a foe near the seven-sixteenths pole, raced inside early on the turn then came off the rail, lacked room behind traffic in upper stretch, altered course to the outside near the three-sixteenths pole and failed to rally. HIDDEN MUSIC was rated on the outside while tugging at the bit, went four wide while let out on the turn, chased into upper stretch and tired. IVY CHAIN was restless in the gate, came out at the start but was quickly corrected, was well placed just off the pace, raced inside while under urging on the turn and came up empty. WEDDING LASS bumped lightly with an opponent at the start then was crowded and dropped back, raced green at the rear

of the field, moved out late on the backstretch, went five wide early on the turn then dropped to three wide and failed to threaten. MY COUSIN ZINNY bumped lightly with rivals at the start, chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn and faded. (Rail at 18 Feet)
