Footnotes

SALLY'S DREAM worked out a tuck along the rail approaching the end of the homestretch, initially sat loosely pocketed, but gradually ranged up to the runner up down the backstretch, eased into the two path leaving the midway point on the far turn, continue to advance towards the leader, rider keeping something in reserve until the stretch, entered the lane and was let out, arrived at the furlong marker on nearly even terms with ROSES FOR ROMNEY, sparrer heads apart with that opponent before kicking clear the final seventy yards, crossing the wire being hand urged. ROSES FOR ROMNEY out broke the field to take charge right from the get-go, cut the pace on an open lead at or just off the rail, rating kindly, continued along on the same scenario for slightly over three-quarters, felt the winner's presence prior to spinning into the stretch and was soon called upon, reached the eighth pole holding only a mere fraction of her former comfortable margin, dueled heads with the winner from before getting shaken off in the last few strides. CARIBBEAN BEAT unhurried from off the inside, was guided on to the inside route coming to the end of the backstretch, rode the rail all the way to the quarter pole, swung outward and was eventually tipped into the three path a sixteenth down the road, kept pace well with the front runners, but had to settle for the show. ORNELLIA coaxed mainly two wide for six furlongs, was under much stronger handling turning for home three wide, lacked a solid offering. PRINCESS MARA forwardly placed, stalked the second place finisher from off the inside, without ever applying serious pressure, continued along in that role mostly three wide on the second bend, gave way. MAH JONG MADDNES swung three wide into the backstretch but was closer to the rail by the start of the run around the far turn, got taken further inward during its later stages and wound up cutting the corner into the lane, launched a mild run from upper to midstretch then flattened out. TEMPER IN COMMAND three wide around each bend, commenced the stretch much wider, was outrun. COLOR BLIND saved ground until past the five-sixteenths marker, spun sharply six wide into the stretch to no avail. DOWNTOWN HOTTIE underwent a three to four wide journey, folded.
