MEMORY CALL, outrun early, advanced inside on the turn, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely while posing no threat to the winner. COTTAGE GARDEN, hustled along on the backstretch, raced wide and lacked a solid finishing kick. KAYLA'S A GEM was hard-ridden inside, chased the pace and tired in the stretch. ALWAYS TRY LOVE, hustled from the gate, chased the winner into the stretch and gave way in the drive. T STORM was hard-ridden from the start and drifted out badly while tiring in the stretch.
