SILVER WAGON broke inward brushing with DON'T TREAD ON ME at the start, was in hand while behind a wall of horses along the backstretch, raced in traffic on the far turn, charged through along the rail to take command entering the stretch, quickly opened a wide gap when roused nearing the furlong marker then drew off while being ridden out. EUROSILVER rushed up along the rail to contest the early pace, dueled heads apart for five furlongs, drifted off the rail entering the stretch, relinquished the lead to his entymate in upper stretch then continued on well to hold the place. APPLE KRISP battled for the lead while three wide into upper stretch and weakened from his early efforts. INDY raced in the middle of the pack along the backstretch, made a run four wide to threaten at the quarter pole but couldn't sustain his bid. DON'T TREAD ON ME was pinched back a bit after being bumped at the start, trailed along the backstretch, saved ground to the top of the stretch then improving his position with a mild late rally. WAR FEVER was pinched back and bumped at the start then failed to threaten while five wide around the turn. SULTRY'S KAZAM was never a factor. HIGH MINDED chased the leaders while three wide for a half and gave way. SHOCK TREATMENT never reached contention. GOLDEN DIAMOND rushed up along the rail, flashed speed to the far turn and faltered.
