PADDY'S DAISY steadied while rank along the rail on the backstretch, waited patiently while saving ground on the turn, slipped through along the inside to take charge in upper stretch and drew off under good handling. NIVES was reserved early, moved up four wide along the backstretch, closed the gap from outside on the turn, made a run to challenge in upper stretch but couldn't stay with the winner through the final eighth. CLEARLY KATHY steadied in traffic on the first turn, raced well back for six furlongs, swung six wide at the top of the stretch then rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. SOUL STAR sprinted clear in the early stages, set the pace along the rail into upper stretch and weakened. MOUNTAIN MAMBO raced between horses to the turn, advanced three wide into the stretch, was bumped a bit in upper stretch then lacked a strong closing bid. FONDA RONDA lunged in the air at the start, steadied in tight on the first turn and again along the backstretch, raced in traffic on the far turn, lodged a mild rally at the to of the stretch then finished evenly. ISLAND REVERSAL was reserved for five furlongs, rallied four wide on the turn, bumped with MOUNTAIN MAMBO in upper stretch then weakened. OBERON'S GIRL angled in after breaking slowly, saved ground to the turn and rallied mildly. STORMY WEATHER pressed the pace from outside to the turn and tired.
