MAIMONIDES took the lead soon after the start, opened a clear advantage on the turn then drew off with authority while under a vigorous hand ride. SAM'S PASSION settled just off the early pace, angled three wide leaving the turn and closed late to get up for the place in the final strides. GRAND MINSTREL broke inward hitting the side of the gate at the start, pressed the pace outside the winner into upper stretch and weakened late. ECTON checked early between horses, swung five wide at the top of the stretch and rallied mildly. MORAL COMPASS raced up close along the rail into upper stretch and steadily tired thereafter. HIDDEN BAY lunged in the air a bit at the start and never reached contention. U. S. CAVALRY raced in midpack while four wide for a half and lacked a further response. TRE COOL was always outrun while racing very wide throughout. O K ROGER saved ground while racing greenly.
