Footnotes

BULLSBAY saved ground on the first turn, moved out on the backstretch, raced three wide for five furlongs, made a strong move along the rail at the three-eighths pole, split horses on the turn, angled out entering the stretch, charge to the front in midstretch and edged clear under strong right hand urging. MACHO AGAIN raced far back for five furlongs, launched a bid from outside on the turn, swung five wide at the quarter pole and closed late in the middle of the track to gain the place. COMMENTATOR angled in on the first turn after sprinting clear, set a quick pace along the rail to the top of the stretch, relinquished the lead to the winner nearing the furlong marker and weakened late to lose the place. TIZWAY raced up close in the two paths to the turn and steadily tired thereafter. DRY MARTINI never reached contention. SMOOTH AIR raced up close along the inside, lodged a brief move on the turn and gave way.
