MARAM was rated in the middle of the pack for five furlongs, rallied three wide on the turn, made a run to challenge in midstretch and edged clear under steady pressure. BLUEGRASS PRINCESS stalked outside, lodged a bid between horses on the turn, battled heads apart into deep stretch and held well for the place. KIAWAH CAT checked on the first turn, raced between horses for a half, angled four wide on the turn then closed late from outside but could not get up. OUR GOLDEN DREAM checked in traffic at the half mile pole, steadied along the inside on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and rallied belatedly after moving back to the rail in midstretch. STRIKING DANCER set the pace on the rail into midstretch and tired. PROJECT ROSE steadied along the rail on the first turn, angled in early, swung four wide at the quarter pole and lacked a late response. MYSTIC MIRACLE failed to threaten while four wide. COMPLICITY pressed between horses and gave way on the turn.
