R BOY BILL bumped with a rival at the start, showed good speed, moved to the lead near the half-mile pole then shook clear, dictated terms while inside on the turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch, was challenged by BIG BENTLEY near the furlong marker, dug in resolutely on the inside and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. BIG BENTLEY came out a bit at the start but broke alertly, showed good speed, was eased back behind the winner near the half-mile pole, came off the rail while still in hand on the turn, was roused in upper stretch, closed well to make a bid passing the eighth-pole, drew alongside the winner late but was denied. PERREGAUX bumped with a rival at the start, was urged along while off the pace, came under a strong ride while off the rail on the turn, lugged inward while green in upper stretch and finished well for the show. VOODOO STORM was ridden along while off the pace, moved in to save ground on the turn, came a bit off the rail at the top of the stretch, shifted out near the furlong marker and lacked the needed response. MISH MOSH angled to the rail early, was urged along in third, saved ground on the turn and came up empty. ROCKY FORTUNE was last away, raced towards the rear of the field, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. I AM PRINCE RAHY raced towards the back of the field while off the rail, ducked inward in upper stretch and failed to respond. HANSEATIC (GER) was reserved at the back of the field, raced off the rail on the turn and showed little. (Rail at 12 Feet)
