LA CLOCHE settled on the outside, advanced three then four wide on the far turn, was asked for her best approaching the quarter-pole, closed well to get the lead near the three-sixteenths pole, battled determinedly in the final furlong and held off all challengers under left hand urging. VEE reared at the start and was off slow, was hard held near the back of the field, bided her time while behind traffic on the far turn, angled in and rallied boldly between rivals inside the furlong marker, bumped with VEE near the sixteenth-pole, battled gamely to the wire and earned the place but could not overtake the winner. SPARKY'S DREAM settled on the inside, waited while continuing to save ground on the far turn, rallied on the rail entering the final furlong, bumped with VEE near the sixteenth-pole, fought determinedly late and just missed the place. SENADA was caught four wide on the first turn then reserved on the outside, went three to four wide on the far turn, steadied slightly then came between rivals in upper stretch and finished well but just missed the minor awards. SILK ROUTE was unhurried while off the rail, remained patient on the far turn, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, swung five wide for room outside the three-sixteenths pole, held a good striking position into the final furlong and finished willingly but lacked the needed kick late. PICTURE HAT bumped lightly with a rival at the start, was hard held in third, came under some urging while three wide midway through the far turn, moved up to make a bid between rivals approaching the furlong marker but gave way. ELLE SPECIAL was away awkwardly then bumped lightly with a rival, moved to the lead nearing the first turn, set the pace on a clear lead, was headed near the three-sixteenths pole and also gave way. APHRODITE'S TEARS lagged at the rear of the field, saved ground on both turns, angled out sharply in mid-stretch and reached her best stride too late. NO ACRONYMS raced three wide on the first turn, was reserved towards the outside, went four wide on the far turn, moved to the six path outside the three-sixteenths pole and failed to rally. OLIVE EYE went straight to the lead, relinquished the lead nearing the first turn, was rated in second, chased the leader on the far turn and stopped abruptly. (Rail at 12
