Footnotes

QUEEN OF KING ST raced three wide into the first turn, made her way to the inside by the seven-eighths pole, contested the pace, vied inside on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, battled with EMPRESS OF GOLD while under a left handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a right-handed whip near the eighth-pole, inched slightly further ahead of the aforementioned rival shortly thereafter and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. EMPRESS OF GOLD raced off the rail on the initial turn, contested the pace while outside on the backstretch, vied outside on the far turn, was asked approaching the quarter-pole, battled with QUEEN OF KING ST while under right hand urging in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip near the eighth-pole, continued to battle outside in the final furlong and missed. MARIA'S OWN raced inside on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, chased while near the rail on the far turn, came under a right-handed whip near the five-sixteenths pole, switched to a left-handed whip in upper stretch, gained on the tired leaders in the final furlong and just got the show. AMERICAN ANGEL raced four then three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace while on the outside, dropped back while three wide and hard ridden on the far turn, remained under a strong drive in upper stretch, gained ground on the tired leaders in the final furlong and just missed the show. FILE GUMBO settled while off the inside, came under some urging with a half-mile to run, was ridden along on the far turn, gained on the tired leaders in the final furlong and also missed the show. EXPRESSO RUN was hustled from the start, raced inside on the first turn, dropped well behind the field, was urged along on the far turn, shifted three wide into the stretch, drifted in under left hand urging near the three-sixteenths pole, dropped to the rail around the eighth-pole, raced under mild encouragement thereafter then was eased up in the final sixteenth while seemingly in contention for the minor awards. VILLA was a bit green into the first turn, raced four wide on that turn, settled well off the pace, dropped to the inside on the far turn, saved ground into the stretch and faltered then was not urged while being taken care of in the final furlong.
