### Footnotes

TOQUE left well and took up a forward position early down the chute, contently stalked the ongoing pace fight, parked out in the three path, moved up to join the fracas coming to the half mile pole, disputed the pace, the widest of a trio from that station to the five-sixteenths pole, already under some encouragement by that juncture, turned for home with a clear advantage and was set down to a steady left handed whip, increased the margin during the ensuing furlong, had the rider switch the stick over to opposite side thereafter and held safely. AWESOME MICH inward a bit, was lightly bumped at the break, was three wide departing the backstretch, maneuvered one path wider early on the turn, was coaxed along to keep pace with the pace dispute, came under stronger handling by the five-sixteenths pole before put to a full drive a sixteenth later, closed the gap gradually throughout the stretch run, but had to settle for being second best. UNBRIDLED DANGER bumped between rivals at the start, sat within range from the outside, proved no match for the top twosome. DANCE FLOOR MANIAC was guided over to the inside in time for the run around the bend, argued for the lead with another pair from the half mile pole to the five-sixteenths pole, remained prominently placed until midstretch and tied. HURRICANE HEAT bumped at the start, swung three wide into lane, had no offering to tender. SURE SUCCESS bumped soundly between rivals out of the starting gate, angled quickly to take up residence along the rail, saved ground thereafter, made a mild run to improve position during the initial portion of the stretch run, then flattened out. GREEN BANANAS saved ground on turn, angled outward coming into the stretch, had no response. ECONOMIC SWOON pressed the issue between opponents from the half mile pole to late on the turn before backing away. LEAP DAY bumped between rivals at the start, raced three wide while displaying brief foot.
