### Footnotes

MYRTLE'S GRAY stalked the front runners while racing along the outside, moved up willingly and wrested away the two path from LETSHOOTPOOL leaving the five-sixteenths pole, was in hot pursuit of the pacesetter when floated four wide into the top of the lane by that opponent, got straightened away and continued to bear down hard, poked a head in front at the eighth pole and edged away under good handling. AKIRA pulled off STRATEGIC MISSILE before contact could be made, was hand urged to take control, cut the pace towards the inside, facing mild resistance all the while, drifted into the three path heading into the stretch, taking the top one along for a short ride, offered some resistance before yielding with about an eighth to go, continued on with good courage to be well clear of the others for place honors. CATCHAPENNY K. darted over to the rail soon after the start, took the inside route thereafter, was under a drive cutting the corner into the stretch, got up for the show. LIGHTS OUT LISA three wide for most of the way around the turn, lacked the necessary stretch response. LETSHOOTPOOL gave chase on the front runner almost from the get-go, lost position to the eventual winner in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, appeared to backing away, when she lost additional position spinning into the lane, when carried outward from pressure originating from the runner up. GUYANA PRINCESS appeared to be getting out midway on the turn, remained well off the inside for the remainder of the turn and coming into the stretch, tired. STRATEGIC MISSILE stumbled badly at the break and was outrun thereafter. PORKCHOP SANDRA was through after completing the half.
