KITTY PANDA came away in good order, was urged along while off the pace, raced two then three wide on the turn, was put to a left-handed whip in upper stretch, rallied on the outside and closed well to win going away. SHEA DARBY came out at the start, was hustled to the lead, crossed towards the inside while showing good speed, was challenged by SWEET SWAY on the turn, shook off that rival in upper stretch, was put to a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker, led into the final sixteenth but was overtaken while clear for the place. PHYSICAL DELIVERY dropped back while ridden along, went four then three wide on the turn, angled back to four wide at the top of the stretch, came under a left-handed whip in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole and outfinished SPINIT TO WINIT to get the show. SPINIT TO WINIT dropped back on the inside, moved out near the half-mile pole, went three then two wide on the turn, moved out under a drive in upper stretch and missed the show. SWEET SWAY drifted out at the start, rushed up on the outside to chase the pace, raced three wide on the turn, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, lost touch with the winner while under the whip in upper stretch and tired. AUNT TIPSY was reluctant to load, raced off the pace while ridden along, lugged in near the half-mile pole, dropped towards the rail while under heavy right-rein pressure, raced off the rail early on the turn, dropped to the inside by the five-sixteenths and failed to respond. SWEET IRISH EMILY was last away, dropped well behind and was always outrun. WILDCAT'S ELEMENT chased the pace, raced inside early on the turn then came off the rail and faded.
