Footnotes

MY MISS AURELIA got away awkwardly by stumbling at the start, recovered, and quickly settled into stride, making her way under a firm hold by the pilot, was prodded into the four path nearing the end of the backstretch by the runner up, remained on hold during the initial portion of the run around the bend, cruised up towards the front runners under her own when ready, spun the widest of the front runners well positioned for the stretch drive, went on a little further before being given her cue, this occurring in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, lugged in from that station until the sixteenth pole, basically ridden with one hand, with the other, namely the right one applying a solid grip on the rein trying as best as possible to stay on a truer course, had that grip relaxed with about a sixteenth to go, then finished unasked for speed in the final seventy yards. DELIGHTFUL QUALITY was tipped into the three path coming to the half mile pole before MY MISS AURELIA could secure it, underwent a three wide pursuit, was put to encouragement in upper stretch, came inward, herded towards the rail a pair of opponents, one of which was steadied (SRUMDIDDLYUMPTIOUS) while the rider of the other (WELL KEPT) kept on riding, proved no match for the top one leaving the furlong marker, but continued onward willingly for second. WELL KEPT tracked from the inside, was carried inward slightly from pressure initiated by the second place finisher, but with no real loss of ground or momentum through it all, held on well for the show. SRUMDIDDLYUMPTIOUS was quickly taken over to the rail, showed the way facing good resistance, had drifted into the two path by the midway point on the turn, appeared to be weakening when carried inward by DELIGHTFUL QUALITY in upper stretch, had the rider check in tight quarters, drifted outward while continuing to tire thereafter. XUNLEI ducked outward at the start, yet out broke this field of five by a slight margin, was taken back soon afterwards, chased the leader from off the inside for a half before backing away.
