Footnotes

TAKE HER TOTHE TOP jumped awkwardly over the first fence which placed her near the back, settled towards the rear, advanced while skipping the seventh fence on the inside, drafted behind horses late on the final bend, rallied between opponents in upper stretch, closed well to make a bid coming to the final fence, jumped awkwardly over that fence allowing THE GREY EXPRESS to moved a bit ahead again, quickly accelerated to the front once regaining stride and powered clear in a strong finish. THE GREY EXPRESS (GB) jumped well while saving ground in second position, made a bid after skipping the seventh fence, moved clear into the stretch, led over the final fence, jumped better then the winner which kept her in front, lost the advantage shortly thereafter and proved no match while well clear for the place. WELL FASHIONED jumped well while racing on the inside, came under urging on the third turn, held a good striking position into the stretch but weakened while best of the rest. KISSER N RUN settled the widest of the field, swerved to avoid the fallen foe after clearing the third fence, lobbed along towards the rear, chased in a good striking position before the final fence but tired. LILLEHAMMER opened up a huge lead while jumping well, lost the advantage on the final bend and gave way. OPERA HEROINE went three wide on the first bend, settled towards the front, chased three wide on the final bend and came up empty. CASABLANCA LILY (IRE) settled off the pace, jumped well throughout and failed to respond. EURO POWER jumped late at fence four, lingered towards the back and left the course before the ninth fence. CUBIST bobbed at the first fence, fell well behind and left the course before the ninth fence. HUNTER FORWARD (AUS) fell over the third fence, returned to his feet, was brought back to the unsaddling area and walked off. AFTER THE FALL ON THE THIRD FENCE, ALL HORSES WHERE DIRECTED TO THE INSIDE OF THE SEVENTH FENCE TO AVOID THE INJURED RIDER.
