STAKES New York Stallion Series S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

INNER TURF FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD WHICH ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THE NEW YORK STALLION STAKES. By subscription of \$200 due on or before December 1, 2010 or \$1,000 due on or before December 1, 2011 or \$5,000 due on or before September 1, 2012. A supplemental nomination fee of \$5,000 can be made at any time prior to the close of entries only if the stallion was fully subscribed and registered to the stallion stakes in the year of the progenies birth and such payment will qualify the horse for all future stallion stake races. \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 5% of purses won to be awarded to the stallion nominator. 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstake at a mile or over on the turf in 2013 or three races allowed 2 lbs.; a sweepstake or two races on the turf, 4 lbs.; a race at a mile or over on the turf, 6 lbs (Maiden and claiming races not considered). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

Footnotes

FROSTY BAY was carried in at the start then in tight off heels, raced off the rail on the first turn, settled on the outside, was roused while three to four wide on the far turn, rallied outside into the final furlong under a right-handed whip and closed strongly to win going away. IMAGE OF NOON was a bit eager while three then two wide on the first turn, raced just off the pace while nicely placed, dropped to the inside on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, moved out under a drive in upper stretch, chased under a right-handed whip into the final furlong, made a bid at the sixteenth-pole, led briefly at that juncture but was overtaken while clear for the place. PALACE DREAMS moved out in the early going, tracked the pace on the outside, moved closer with five furlongs to run, prompted the pacesetter from that point, vied three then two wide on the far turn, was asked in the vicinity of the quarter-pole, duelled with JOHN'S MARIAH in upper stretch, bumped with the aforementioned rival at the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while just able to get the show. JOHN'S MARIAH angled in from the start, went to the front, raced inside on the first turn, set the pace while off the inside on the back stretch, dropped back to the rail midway through the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, duelled with PALACE DREAMS in upper stretch, had the rider lose his whip outside the furlong marker, bumped with the aforementioned rival near the sixteenth-pole and was outkicked then just missed the show. SUS ANNMARIES GOLD

was carried in at the start, went three wide on the first turn, moved up on the outside with five furlongs to run, raced three to four wide on the far turn, was roused near the quarter-pole, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, drifted inward in the final furlong and lacked then needed response. ADRIATIC DREAM saved ground on the first turn, settled towards the rear, raced off the rail early on the far turn, was driven four wide nearing the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. LISALISALEE went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, dropped inward in upper stretch and failed to rally. FANTASTIC EYES raced off the inside on the first turn, settled off the pace, went three then two wide on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and also failed to rally. JERUSALEM STONE raced inside on the first turn, settled off the rail on the backstretch, was roused while off the rail on the far turn and failed to respond. MAXANA settled on the inside, dropped back while ridden along and continuing to save ground on the far turn and faltered. (Rail at 18 Feet)
