MARQUETTE, close up early while well in hand, advanced outside on the second turn, responded when asked for run, reached the front nearing the eighth pole and drew clear under a drive. PHI BETA DOC, rated along inside, slipped through along the hedge on the second turn, came three wide for the drive and finished gamely. GOOD NIGHT, rated along early, advanced inside on the second turn, found room in upper stretch and finished gamely inside. MONKEY PUZZLE, rated outside, rallied five wide on the second turn and lacked a solid finishing kick. PASSINETTI, outrun early, rallied inside on the second turn and finished with some interest. SPECIAL COACH, rank in the gate, prompted the pace while in hand and weakened in the final furlong. AIR ROCKET, outrun early, raced four wide on the first turn and six wide on the second turn. CERTAINLY CLASSIC, set the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. HOLDITHOLDITHOLDIT, close up inside early on, was put to the whip on the backstretch but had no response. GONE NORTH tired after the opening three quarters. HOYLE, rated along outside, raced wide and tired. DANCE THE BALLADO raced three wide on both turns and tired. INFELD SHIFT stumbled badly at the start and tired.
