DOC'S DOLL raced close up in hand, came wide approaching the stretch, cruised to the front above the eighth pole, drew clear when roused and report promptly under a drive. BACK BAY LADY was unhurried outside, raced wide and rallied outside for the place spot. GENEVIL raced with the pace along the inside and faded on the rail in the stretch. TAP MACHINE was outrun early, raced wide and was going well too late. CHARM APPEAL set the pace and tired in the final furlong. CAJUN KELLY raced close inside and posed no real threat. AMARETTO was outrun early, raced wide and showed some interest from the outside after the fact. BRIANS MOVE raced inside and had no response when roused. SANGUE TOO LOUD raced wide throughout and tired. CURE JUDYS BLUES tired. WINLOC'S SUNSHINE showed brief speed, bore out on the turn and drifted out in the stretch.
