 (UP TO \$28,500 NYSBFOA) INNER TURF FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$750 to pass the entry box, \$750 to start. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. 122 lbs.; Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake on the turf in 2004 allowed 3 lbs.; \$45,000 on the turf, 5 lbs., two races, 7 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, or restricted allowance races not considered). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, July 24, 2004 with 38 nominations.

ARTIE SCHILLER raced along between rivals while well in hand, was confidently handled around the second turn, came wide into the stretch, responded when asked, quickly drew clear and widened while being kept busy to the finish. MUSTANFAR hit the gate at the start, was outrun early, rallied four wide on the second turn, dug in gamely outside and got the nod for the place award. GOOD REWARD, close up inside while well in hand, was steadied in upper stretch, altered course to the outside and dug in gamely to the finish, just missing for the place prize. SECOND PERFORMANCE raced close up while three wide, rallied three wide on the second turn, earned a short lead between calls in upper stretch then weakened in the final furlong. ICY ATLANTIC showed good speed along the inside, contested the pace into the stretch and tired on the rail in the final furlong. PREACHINATHEBAR was outrun while between rivals early, came wide into the stretch and had no response when roused. BROADWAY VIEW bobbled at the start, dropped back early, raced inside and tired.. STREET THEATRE contested the pace from the outside, clipped heels in upper stretch, stumbled and dropped back. Following a Stewards' inquiry into the stretch run the result was declared official.
