MYAKKA dueled for the early lead from outside, shook loose on the turn, opened a wide gap in upper stretch and drew off to a lengthy score while being kept to the task. REVERSIBLE ERROR settled well back along the inside, saved ground through the turn and rallied mildly to clearly best the others. SAND AND SONG was unhurried for a half, circled five wide advancing into the stretch and failed to threaten while improving her position. NICELY PUT dueled early inside the winner, dropped back on the turn and steadily tired thereafter. LAST BOAT HOME raced just behind the leaders while three wide to the turn and lacked a further response. WISE CHOICE away slowly, checked in traffic on the far turn, steadied between horses nearing the quarter pole, swerved seven wide entering the stretch then lugged in while racing greenly through the lane. BEST CROSSING failed to mount a serious rally while four wide. AMEZCUA'S PLAY was outrun in the two path for most of the way, lacked a late response.
