Footnotes

BIGSHOT moved in entering the first turn, raced off the rail on that turn, was reserved on the outside, moved closer while three then four wide on the far turn, was roused in upper stretch, closed well to get the lead nearing the furlong marker and edged clear under one crack of a left-handed whip then strong hand urging. UNPRECEDENTED settled between rivals, clipped the heels of ANNAWON near the three-eighths pole and stumbled, dropped to the rail entering the stretch, came out to make a bid passing the furlong marker but was outfinished while able to secure the place. TOUCH OF SILVER bumped with PIERRE LAPIN after the start, raced inside on the first turn, settled off the rail on the backstretch, went two to three wide on the far turn, was roused near the quarter-pole, shifted out in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick but got up for the show. DISTANT SKY moved to the early lead, set the pace on the inside, was set down at the top of the stretch, lost the lead nearing the furlong marker and gave way then was caught for the show late. BOISTEROUS was unhurried while saving ground, continued to save ground through the far turn, swung four wide at the top of the stretch, moved further out approaching the sixteenth-pole and improved position. JOSHUA REYNOLDS was rated on the inside, lost position when ANNAWON dropped in near the five-sixteenths pole, was roused at the top of the stretch and failed to rally. ZHIVAGO leaned in and hit the gate at the start then bumped with PIERRE LAPIN, lagged at the rear of the field while saving ground, came off the rail in upper stretch and failed to threaten. ANNAWON prompted the pace while off the rail, had UNPRECEDENTED clip his heels inside the three-eighths pole, dropped to the inside near the five-sixteenths pole, was in tight entering the stretch and came up empty. DEFLATIONARY FEARS raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and also came up empty. PIERRE LAPIN was bumped on both sides at the start then clipped heels and stumbled, settled towards the rear of the field while off the rail, came three wide into the stretch and was no factor. SAVANNAH BAY raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased while off the rail on the far turn and tired. (Rail at 12 Feet)
