WESTERN TEASE broke alertly, prompted the pacesetter three wide, under a good hold, inched up to that foe during the run around the bend, with the rider continuing to keep something in reserve, reached even terms at the quarter pole, got hooked up in a stretch duel with JACK ON THE ROCKS from that point, matched strides with that opponent with neither ever being more than a head in front, finally grabbed the lead a few strides prior to the end to prove best. JACK ON THE ROCKS established command soon after the start, set the pace from the two path while being well rated until the quarter pole, was put to the test by the top one turning for home, proceeded to race as a team before reluctantly yielding just before the finish line, in a good try. INDEPENDENCE WAR within range outside, displayed a mild rally to earn the show, while never posing a serious threat to the top pair at any point. CAIXA ELETRONICA urged on the turn, lacked the necessary stretch response. ELTISH STAR was no factor. MORE THAN A REASON was put to a hard, prolonged drive, soon after departing the half mile pole, failed to gain any ground. WEST COAST FLIER stumbled at the start, was eased back early along the backstretch, sat well placed and reserved until midway on the turn, was asked for a response and folded.
