HIGHER DESIRE raced within range four wide around the turn, entered the lane from out there, responded well when called upon, closed in on the front runner, continued onward leaving the furlong grounds, drew alongside a weakening WATKINS GLEN in deep stretch, took over after a couple of additional strides and prevailed, driving. GINGER SNAPIT urged leaving the starting gate, bumped with MISS GRIEVANCE shortly after the start, recovered to assume a forward position, was put to encouragement to keep pace during the run around the bend, was green in the stretch, lugged inward, despite left handed pressure, hitting the rail in upper stretch, got back going, was forced to be taken in hand and alter course around the eighth pole when WATKINS GLEN swerved inward sharply, then managed to muster up some late interest to garner place honors. WATKINS GLEN broke out a bit at the start, accelerated with a high turn of speed to the front after being straightened away, actually poking a head in front for a stride or two, was allowed to ease back, rather than risk a potential head to head duel, advanced when ready for another go at the leader nearing the quarter pole, grabbed the lead shortly into the stretch drive, swerved in sharply at the furlong marker, putting the runner up in a bit tight, began to shorten stride noticeably by the sixteenth pole, was overhauled, getting outfinished for the place as well. GIN CAT outrun during the early stages, came home with a mild rally to take the last major share of the purse. APTPHILLY took the inside route, angled three wide at the quarter pole, lacked the necessary stretch response. MISS GRIEVANCE shot of the gate to grab the early lead in a flash despite bumping with GINGER SNAPIT shortly after the break, was headed briefly by WATKINS GLEN nearing the half mile pole, regained a clear advantage when that rival was taken back, showed the way from the two path around the turn, was confronted by WATKINS GLEN for the second time turning for home, offered some resistance before yielding

no factor. PROUD DAME bobbled after the break, went four wide around the turn but failed to reach a contending position. FAVORITE NOTE was outrun. WINTER PARADE DOLL saved ground and trailed throughout.
