WARRIOR UP came away in good order, settled while off the inside, was roused on the far turn, gained ground into the stretch, rallied between rivals while under right hand urging, closed well to get the lead inside the furlong marker, inched clear into the final sixteenth and held under strong urging. AMBIT saved ground on the first turn, was reserved while off the rail on the backstretch, came under urging while between rivals on the far turn, dropped to the inside near the three-sixteenths pole, tried to go inside of the pacesetter outside the furlong marker, failed to have enough room, was blocked then checked, moved to the outside shortly thereafter, regained momentum outside the sixteenth-pole and finished fast but was too late in a tough trip. CHILTON hit the outside of the gate at the start, tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, battled into the final furlong and was outfinished while able to get the show. ALL ZIPPED UP went three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased four wide on the far turn, pursued the leaders into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick then just missed the show. ROVER broke a bit slow then was sluggish into

stride, saved ground on the first turn, lingered at the back, was roused while off the rail early on the far turn, shifted four wide near the five-sixteenths pole, came five wide into the stretch and finished with good energy on the far outside. TYCOON CAT was off slow, spotted the field three to four lengths, raced off the rail on the first turn, moved up on the outside down the backstretch, was ridden along while three wide on the far turn, shifted out under left hand urging in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. LOGICAL ORDER came away well, quickly went to the front and crossed over, set the pace while off the rail, was challenged on the far turn, lost the lead in upper stretch, battled into the final furlong and gave way. RALLY POINT was reserved off the pace, came under urging while two to three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. MY LUCA was hustled from the start, raced inside on the first turn, settled near the rail, came under urging with a half-mile to run, was ridden along while saving ground on the far turn and lacked the needed response. ROCKY WORLD settled on the inside, came under urging leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn and failed to threaten.
