Footnotes

START JUMPING drifted out some early, stalked the leading duo on the outside, ranged up in the five path early on the turn, made a bid passing the three-eighths pole, moved clear while still in the five path outside the quarter-pole, was roused while four wide into the stretch, extended the advantage under hand urging, came under a right-handed whip at the furlong marker, switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and proved much the best under continued left-hand urging. JOEY N was hustled from the start then ridden along on the outside, went four then five wide on the turn, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch and finished willingly while second best. KEYALY brushed with an opponent at the start, settled at the rear of the field, was urged along while inside early on the turn, shifted three wide near the quarter-pole, drifted out under a left-handed whip in upper stretch and safely secured the show. OPTIONALITY was ridden along on the outside, went six wide on the turn, was carried out while under the whip in upper stretch and failed to respond. LIKE A BOSS was hustled from the start, moved out passing the three-quarter pole, pressed the pace on the outside, drew even near the seven-sixteenths pole, vied two to three wide on the turn, dropped out at the quarter-pole and faded. SILVER SHOT brushed with a rival at the start, showed good natural speed, set the pace under pressure, vied off the rail on the turn, dropped a bit closer to the inside while falling back at the quarter-pole and stopped.
