SWEET REASON away with no apparent mishap, received some hand urging as motivation almost immediately afterwards, picked up speed noticeably nearing midpoint on the turn, was under a drive spinning four wide full of run, lost none of the momentum, rapidly cutting into the leader's advantage, collared that opponent in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, drew clear, crossing the finish line under a less than vigorous hand ride. SKY CREW broke alertly and was sharply taken towards the inside, took up residence in the two path, raced directly alongside BOOM BOOM VROOM around the bend, shook free and was asked for her best, arrived at the eighth pole with none latched on but with the winner closing in fast, proved powerless to stave that foe off, relinquishing with about a sixteenth remaining, easily held on for place honors. MISS LECH chased from the two path on the turn, made no impact en route for the show. AMELIATHEAVIATOR placed near the two path approaching the end of the backstretch, was no factor. LEMON POINT three wide at the three-eighths pole, was outrun. BOOM BOOM VROOM rushed up to engage the runner up, sparred with that rival from the three path, gave way. AMORE GRAND three to four wide on the turn, the widest of all, was never in contention. HANDSHAKESNKISSES faded off a ground-saving journey and got eased in the final furlong.
