FLASHY AMERICAN unhurried during the opening stages, advanced with good speed when let out a notch a few strides past the half mile pole, making it into the four path by the five-sixteenths marker, got roused spinning into the lane, closed in readily racing through the furlong grounds, outfinished a pair with about a sixteenth remaining to take over in the final seventy yards and kick clear. STREET SECRET made slight contact with MOON PHILLY coming to the top of the opening turn, stalked the pacesetter three wide travelling along it and on the next turn as well, picked up the pace nearing the quarter pole and challenged in earnest, made some but not significant ground from upper to midstretch, forged onward and had more success afterwards, battled between rivals in the late stages, failed to keep up with the winner but held on in a willing manner for the place. LADY COHIBA broke on top and maintained control, cut the pace, well rated in the two path and on a loosely-contested lead, continued along on the same scenario until the quarter pole, felt an increase in pressure at that juncture and was set down, held her ground well during the ensuing furlong, got hooked up a a three-way tussle a sixteenth later, eventually yielding to each of them in the final seventy yards. MOON PHILLY bumped lightly with STREET SECRET approaching the end of the homestretch after getting out raced for the three path, tucked into it soon afterwards and loosely drafted behind the aforementioned rival, was closer to the rail on the subsequent one, got put to a drive prior to reaching the five-sixteenths pole, had no rally. AND WHY NOT three wide entering the far turn, got swung six wide exiting it, was never involved. SEA ISLAND took the inside route until midway down the backstretch, remained well off the rail thereafter, was placed into the four path coming to the five-sixteenths pole, got called upon for the drive, failed to respond and gave way.
