MR. JOHN was hustled to the front, set the pace while between rivals, dug in gamely in the stretch and was driving at the finish. PUT IT BACK was bumped soundly and pinched back from between rivals at the start, was steadied along inside around the turn, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely but could not get by the winner. ROCK SLIDE hesitated at the start, was bumped soundly after the start, dropped far back early then finished gamely too late. TAREK was bumped soundly at the start, chased the pace and had no rally. PERFECT STRANGER raced wide and had no rally. CABOT TRAIL contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. CHARIOT was bumped soundly at the start then was rushed up outside, contested the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. STOP THE BLUFFING had no response when roused.
