Footnotes

MIRACLE MOMENT sprinted clear soon after the start, raced uncontested on the lead while setting a brisk pace to the turn then drew off with authority while being kept to the task. SECRET WITNESS was unhurried for five furlongs, worked her way forward along the inside on the turn, angled three wide while gaining at the quarter pole and finished willingly to gain the place. PHILANTHROPY LADY raced well back for six furlongs, launched a bid slightly off the rail entering the stretch, angled out in midstretch then rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. READY TO TALK raced in close contention between horses for five furlongs, took up chase after the winner on the turn then faded in the stretch. KELTISH LASS was taken in hand on the first turn, saved ground while well back for six furlongs and lacked the needed response when called upon. ELEGANT ELLIE raced closest to the winner along the inside to the turn and steadily tired thereafter. SPARTAN VALOR pinched back at the start, never reached contention while four wide. UNTUTTTABLE GAL chased three wide for five furlongs and gave way.
