LEO'S PEGASUS was rated in good position while three wide along the backstretch, swung four wide advancing into the stretch then unleashed a strong late run in the middle of the track to win going away. SOUTHERN FLU bumped leaving the gate, raced well back for a half, worked her way forward along the inside on the far turn, angled between horses then checked in traffic nearing the quarter pole, angled back to the rail entering the stretch, made a strong run to challenge inside the furlong marker but couldn't withstand the winner's late charge. SHADY LANE broke outward a bit at the start, raced in hand while slightly off the rail on the first turn, settled just behind the leaders while saving ground along the backstretch, angled between horses nearing the quarter pole, made a run to challenge in upper stretch, battled into midstretch and weakened late. A BIT OF PRESSURE sprinted to the front soon after the start, set the pace along the rail into upper stretch and drifted out while weakening in the final eighth. MORAVIA bumped at the start, clipped heels and stumbled in the early stages, raced well back while saving ground for six furlongs, moved between horses on the turn and lacked a strong closing response. EL COYOTE bumped and carried out at the start, rushed up from outside, prompted the pace for five furlongs, lodged a brief bid on the turn and faded in the stretch. FUEGO GRANDE checked at the start and was never close thereafter.
