### Footnotes

COOL COAL MAN was well placed while saving ground, rallied inside to take the lead in upper stretch and drew off under a vigorous hand ride. MORE THAN A REASON chased the leader from outside, lodged a three wide move on the turn but was no match for the winner. DR. D. F. C. was outrun to the turn and rallied mildly. LE GRAND CRU set the pace on the rail and gave way at the quarter pole. READY SET saved ground to no avail. BARRIER REEF raced just off the pace between horses and gave way on the turn. DA' TARA lunged in the air at the start, rushed up four wide, raced up close for a quarter then dropped back abruptly and raced well out in the course before being eased late.
