Footnotes

RIZZI'S COMET patiently tracked an ongoing pace dispute while taking the inside route, gained readily late on the turn once the embattled pair starting feeling the effects of their tussle, turned for home with clear sailing along the rail there for the asking, drove past the surviving dueler to take charge by the furlong marker, then kicked clear, crossing the finish line under brisk hand encouragement. D' BULLDOG away alertly, got hooked up in a duel with TACKLE almost from the get-go, raced as a team inches apart with that opponent before shaking free nearing the five-sixteenths pole, had no sooner done so when confronted by the winner, gave into that one's challenge while making his way through the furlong grounds, held well to be second best. BLACK DIABLO along the outside, chased the duel to no avail. STARLANTIC off a beat slowly, was put to encouragement early on the turn, vacated the rail in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, flattened out departing the eighth pole. WAR BALLAD three to four wide on the turn, tired. KARAKORUM BUDMAN angled four wide into upper stretch, had no rally. TACKLE sparred intensely from the two path with the runner up, fell back despite being asked for some run coming to the five-sixteenths pole.
